WHAT THIS CHECKLIST IS, AND WHAT IT IS NOT

This checklist gives an enthusiast the context to follow what is being discussed around a 600LT transaction. It replaces nothing. The Longtail of the Sports Series: a hundred kilos carved from the 570S, exhausts firing over the deck, and one of the most reliable modern McLarens beneath it. The engine is not the question: the track biography is, together with two US campaigns answered by VIN, the ceramics, the chassis wear and a complete McLaren history. An original car with honest paper is the most wanted Sports Series of all, and this checklist protects exactly that. Without the specialist verdict on chassis and history, do not touch the car.

A · IDENTITY & THE RECORD

- ☐ Identity first: coupe or Spider, specification and options against the record.
- ☐ Complete McLaren service history; ownership chain traced.
- ☐ VIN campaign check: 21V561 and 23V484 closed, plus all service measures.
- ☐ Track biography established honestly: events, tyre sets, brake sets.
- ☐ Originality confirmed: seats, aero, wheels, exhausts, all documented.
- ☐ Every document photographed for the collector dossier.

B · POWERTRAIN

- ☐ Cold start filmed: even idle, oil pressure, no smoke.
- ☐ Turbos and boost checked; coolant system sighted, the 23V484 area included.
- ☐ Oil loss and engine mounts inspected.
- ☐ SSG: clutch readout, adaptations, shift quality in all modes.
- ☐ Software level and fault memory read.

C · CHASSIS, BRAKES & TRACK

- ☐ Ceramics measured: discs, pads, temperature history, cracks.
- ☐ Brake function corner by corner: the 21V561 lesson.
- ☐ Chassis bushings, top mounts and full measurement on any tracked car.
- ☐ Underbody and carbon parts walked: splitter and sills tell the truth.
- ☐ Lift system where fitted, IRIS and drive modes function-tested.
- ☐ Tyres by age and use: track rubber ages faster than it wears.

D · PRICE & INVESTIGATION ITEMS

The drivetrain is the calm part: the price sits in the biography, the ceramics, the chassis and the paper.

- ☐ Ceramic discs near limits: quoted, the big consumable of this car.
- ☐ Chassis wear on a tracked example: the full package quoted.
- ☐ Open campaigns: closed before money moves.
- ☐ Clutch state on a tracked car: readout and quote.
- ☐ Missing original parts: sourcing priced before purchase.
- ☐ Service gaps: priced as documentation risk on a collector-grade car.
- ☐ Negotiate from the biography, the measurements and the record.

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E · RED FLAGS · WALK-AWAY OR ESCALATION

- A track car sold as a garage queen: tyre dates and brake wear tell the truth.
- Unverified campaign status on either recall.
- Coolant traces in the engine bay: the documented 23V484 pattern.
- Uneven braking or corner findings talked away.
- Heavy modification sold as improvement without the original parts.
- A service history outside the McLaren world.
- A seller who resists the specialist inspection.
- A car whose findings cannot be named, quantified and priced.

F · FIRST WEEK OF OWNERSHIP

- ☐ The dossier archived: service file, campaign confirmations, measurements, originality list, biography.
- ☐ The McLaren specialist relationship established for chassis and track support.
- ☐ Ceramics, tyres and fluids baselined; the alignment checked before the first fast lap.

“A hundred kilos lighter and twice as loud, straight up through the deck: the Sports Series at its peak. Read the biography, close both campaigns, keep it original. That car has nowhere to go but up.”
